## **Daedalus Commemorates D-Day 80th**

The 80th D-Day Anniversary Celebrations happened over the 8th—9th June 2024 on the historic former WWII airfield HMS Daedalus.

HMS Daedalus played a vital part D-Day invasion as the RN and RAF were joined by Canadian Typhoons and Mustangs, long with the US Navy Squadron VCS-7.

At 0441 hours on the 6 June 1944, the first aircraft to take part in Operation Overlord from HMS Daedalus departed en-route to the Normandy beach head. HMS Daedalus is a significant place in the part of the overall 80th anniversary, it was the single busiest airfield on D-Day with 435 sorties. This number was the largest achieved by any UK airfield on D-Day



The weekend was a huge success with around 16,000 visitors enjoying the weekends activities.

Daedalus D-Day 80 was administered on behalf of Fareham Borough Council by Montserrat Events CIC who managed the event and ticket sales. Regional & City Airports (RCA) organised and assembled all of the airside activities and aircraft for both static and flying displays

## **Airport Project updates**

#### **Aeronautical Ground Lighting (AGL)**

The AGL works commenced in early 2024 with a proposed completion date of December 2024.

You may have seen a number of yellow poles being installed in the vicinity of the Monks Hill Car park and QEII Platinum Jubilee Park. These are part of the approach lights and are directed towards the approaching in flight aircraft and will not impede any neighbouring properties.

AGL will allow operations in inclement weather and extended opening hours in the winter months until 6pm.









#### **Performance Based Navigation (PBN)**

PBN is a system that allows aircraft to fly on flexible flight paths using onboard equipment and capabilities.

PBN is basically a GPS aid for aircraft, it will allow the airport to offer a method of navigation through an instrument approach and allow pilots to navigate either for training, charter aircraft or in inclement weather and poor visibility, where it will allow pilots to continue to their destination whereas normally they would have to divert to another airfield.

PBN has many benefits, including: Safety, Efficiency, cost and no ground based equipment that needs maintaining.

Both AGL and PBN are a great benefit to maintaining a successful airport and providing a much improved service proposition to our customers.
